Dear Parent /Carer


As part of the History Departments A2 programme we would like to offer your child the opportunity to attend a study day at Hampton Court near London. The purpose of the trip is educational and students will receive expert guidance on the 'Mid Tudor Crisis' and an escorted tour. The guidance is tailored to the AQA course your child is taking, Unit 3B: The triumph of Elizabeth 1558 - 1603. The talk will include the most recent research and historical interpretations.

The cost of the lecture is £25 which includes all travel costs, entrance to Hampton Court and the charge for the talk.

The visit will take place mainly during the school day and the group will meet at school at 8am to travel to Hampton Court for 10.30am and return at 6.00pm on Monday November 14th 2011. The students will either need to take a packed lunch with a drink, or money to buy food at the venue. Whichever option students take it would be advisable to take a spare drink and a snack for the journey. Students will be expected to follow the normal dress code for the VI form on the visit.
